

3. ARRIVAL AND TRANSPORTATION

Passport

Everyone travelling to Jamaica must present a valid and approved travel document as evidence of their identity and nationality. The most common and preferred travel document is a passport, but other types of travel documents may also be accepted. Visa Arrangements

Visas or any documents necessary for travel are the participant's responsibility, and should be obtained prior to departure. Participants should check with the Jamaican Embassy in their country to confirm visa requirements and are responsible for any fees or other costs related to their visa procurement.

Insurance

Participants are encouraged to make arrangements for health and travel insurance coverage, if so desired.

Transportation from the Airport

Upon arrival in Kingston, Jamaica, participants may opt to use buses that are designated to transport participants to their respective hotels. These buses will be marked with the acronym 'JUTA'. The assigned JUTA buses will further be marked with the words 'IPCC Outreach'. Each participant using the designated JUTA buses will be required to pay a fee of approximately US \$35 each way. Taxis are also available at the airport.

Transportation to Meeting Venue from Hotel

Requests can be made at the Front Desk of most hotels for a taxi. Fees vary depending on the location of the hotel. Participants staying in the New Kingston area can expect a drive time to the Meeting venue of approximately 25 minutes in peak hour traffic.

5. INFORMATION ABOUT JAMAICA

Voltage

Outlets are wired for 110volts, 50 hz (cycle).

Weather

Kingston, Jamaica, presently experiences daily temperatures of approximately 30°C (85°F). The weather is humid and tropical. Light, intermittent showers may be experienced during the Outreach Event.

Currency and Transactions

The currency in Jamaica is the Jamaican Dollar and the exchange rate is US\$1.00 =J\$125.00 (when converting to Jamaican currency) as at November 14, 2016. Foreign currency may be exchanged at the airport, some hotels, banks and authorized money exchange shops. A limited number of vendors accept US Dollars. Major Credit Cards are accepted island-wide.
