Background:

The Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) is the UN body for assessing the science related to climate change. Since its inception in 1988 the IPCC has produced five comprehensive Assessment Reports and several Special Reports on specific topics. IPCC has also produced Methodology Reports, which provide practical guidelines on the preparation of greenhouse gas inventories for the inventory reporting requirements of Parties to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC). The IPCC is currently in its Sixth Assessment cycle, during which it will produce three Special Reports, a Methodology Report and the Sixth Assessment Report.

Objective:

This event will present the activities and findings of the IPCC and the production of the Sixth Assessment cycle. It will **raise awareness**, **especially among policymakers**, about the IPCC the work plan, priorities and findings, **enlist the participation of the local science and research community** in climate research and encourage regional contribution to the work of the IPCC.
