GENEVA, 20 September – Following the press conference on Friday 27 September 2013 in Stockholm to present the Summary for Policymakers of the Working Group I contribution to the Fifth Assessment Report of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC), the Co-Chairs and several Bureau members and many authors of Working Group I will be available for interview.

These interviews are expected to take place between 12.00 and 15.00 Stockholm time. Interviews can be conducted at the conference centre where the press conference takes place or by phone for those not attending the press conference.

The IPCC expects to receive more requests than can be accommodated. If your interview request cannot be met on Friday 27 September, there will be further opportunities in the following weeks.
