- In this sense, the need of enhancing the understanding is mutual.



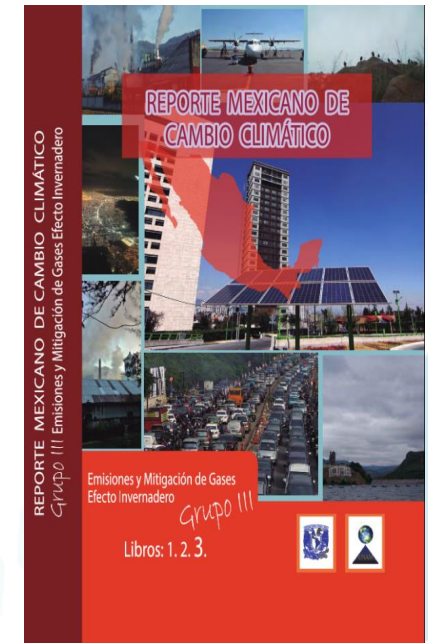
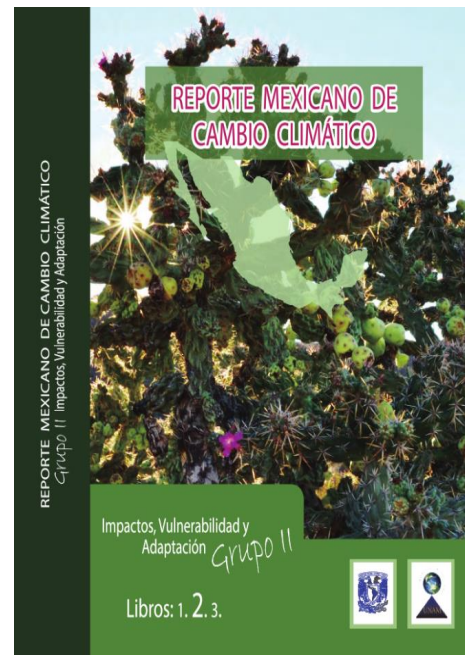
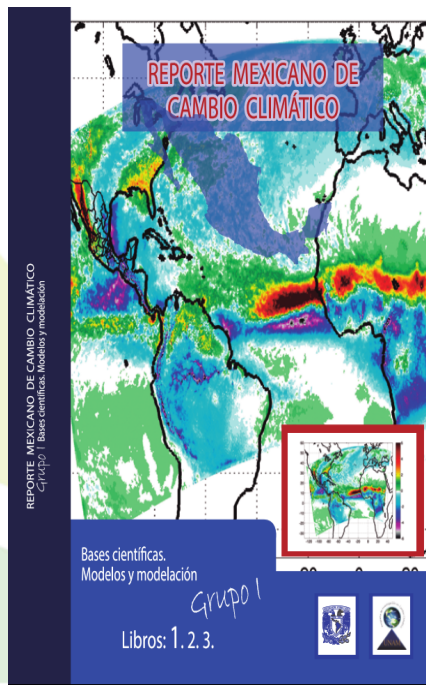
Outreach events at the 45th Session of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC-45)

- IPCC meetings are an opportunity to increase the knowledge about the IPCC work and to increase the interest among the scientist but also among the national and subnational governmental institutions and young people (future scientist).
- Focal points can help in promoting the importance of IPCC work and help disseminating the results of its different reports.
- Public research institutions can:
 - Incorporate IPCC inputs in the construction of climate change policies
 - Promote the development assessments reports at national level to create capacities in local institutions.



The role of IPCC National Focal Points

- Promote the design of national assessments reports.
- Helping to coordinate work among regional IPCC authors.
- Focal points can help in recollecting and made available the scientific papers on specific national or regional problems.



Mexico's Report of Climate Change

- IPCC as a body with updated scientific information can help to create synergies between public policies and best available scientific information.
- Institutions (including the International ones) tend to be conservative. This is the reason why Mexico has decided to encourage that IPCC includes new topics to address emerging needs.
- Paris Agreement has established challenges that implies to look for innovative solutions.
- IPCC could greatly collaborate on this task.
