T3 Pickup Area: Located outside Gate 14 on the arrival level of Terminal 3

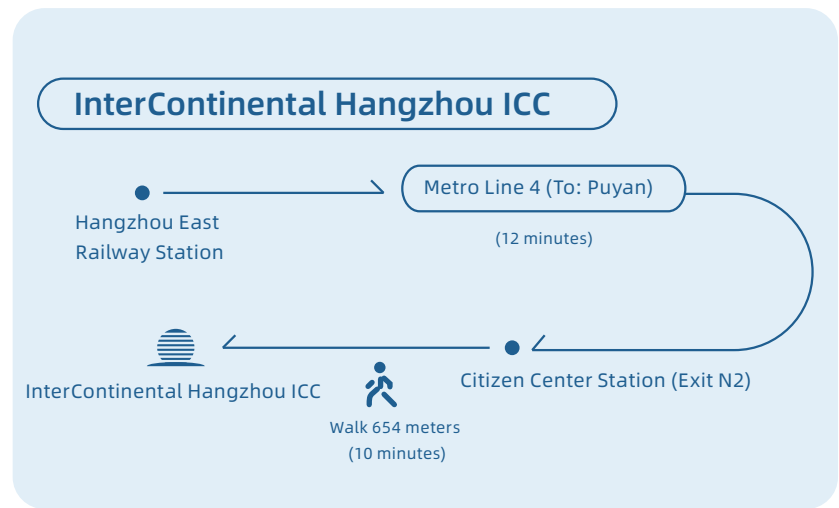
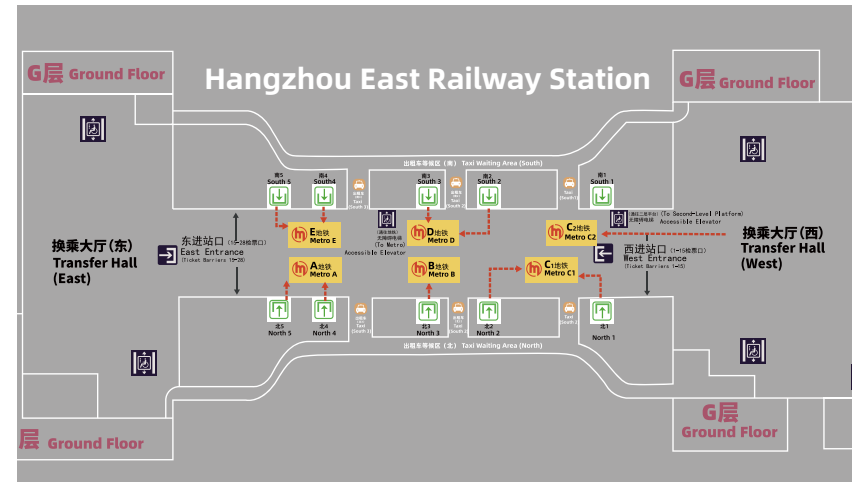

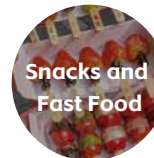
Recommendation 2: Mi street at Citizen Center Metro Station

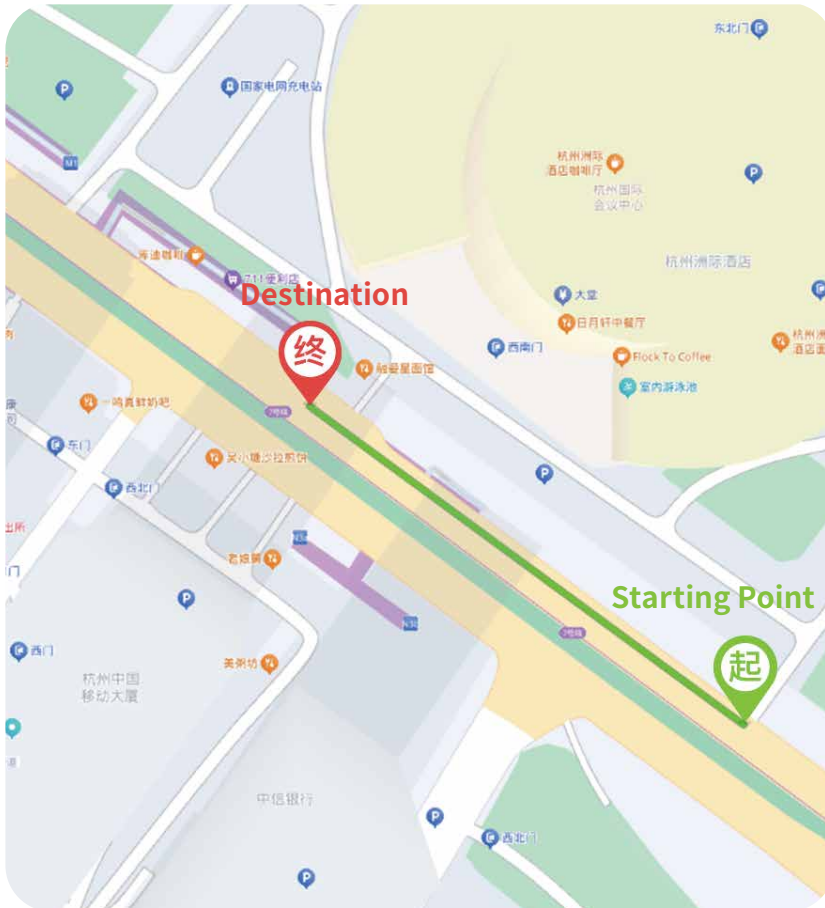

Venue Overview

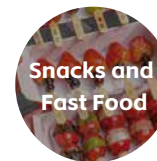

Hangzhou's Scenic Spots and Specialties

Introduction to Hangzhou's Scenic Areas

A veritable "World Heritage City", Hangzhou boasts three UNESCO World Heritages. The West Lake of Hangzhou is one of the most iconic landscape in the country. The Grand Canal, one of the world's oldest and longest artificial waterways, stretches through the heart of the city. The Archaeological Ruins of Liangzhu City, though, is a remarkable testament to China's 5,000-year-old civilization. Together, they showcase the unique facets of Chinese civilization, condensed into a distinctive urban spiritual symbol, and highlight the diverse characteristics and temperament of the region.

West Lake/Xihu

The West Lake Cultural Landscape of Hangzhou, comprising the West Lake and the hills surrounding its three sides, has inspired famous poets, scholars and artists since the 9th century. It comprises numerous temples, pagodas, pavilions, gardens and ornamental trees, as well as causeways and artificial islands. These additions have been made to improve the landscape west of the city of Hangzhou to the south of the Yangtze river. It owns much of its fame to its ten poetically named scenic places, known as the "Ten Views".

Travel tips

The "Ten Views of the West Lake" is based on the artistic creation of the Southern Song Dynasty imperial painters who were fascinated by the fabulous looks of the lake in different seasons of the year, different times of the day, under different weather conditions and enlivened by different wild lives. Each scene focuses on a variety of aesthetic themes. Even with little knowledge about Chinese classical culture, you can intuitively understand its beauty at the time.



The Grand Canal

As a key contributor to Hangzhou's prosperity since ancient times, the Grand Canal has bred and nourished the area's Wuyue culture and Jiangnan culture, producing along its banks the iconic white-walled and black-roofed residence and folkways of a typical southern Chinese water town. Apart from the leisurely life of the locals, the famous handicraft museum cluster is also a must-see where you can experience the traditional intangible cultural heritage skills that have been kept alive to this date.

Travel tips

To see the Canal, you can take the water bus from Wulinmen Pier to Gongchenqiao Pier, get off the boat and visit the such sights as the handicrafts museum group, Gongchen Bridge, Qiaoxi Historic Block, Xiaohezhijie Block, Xiaohe Park and others. Or you may take a canal cruise to Tangqi ancient town, to learn about traditions and cultures of an old jiangnan town.



Liangzhu Ancient City

Liangzhu, aka the "Land of Beauty", is a living museum where visitors can explore the remnants of this ancient civilization through archaeological sites, exhibitions, and interactive experiences. It stands as a symbol of China's rich cultural heritage and early urban development.

West Lake Longjing Tea
